Articles that pertain to Corvettes, A.V.C.C members, or the Antelope Valley are always welcomed.

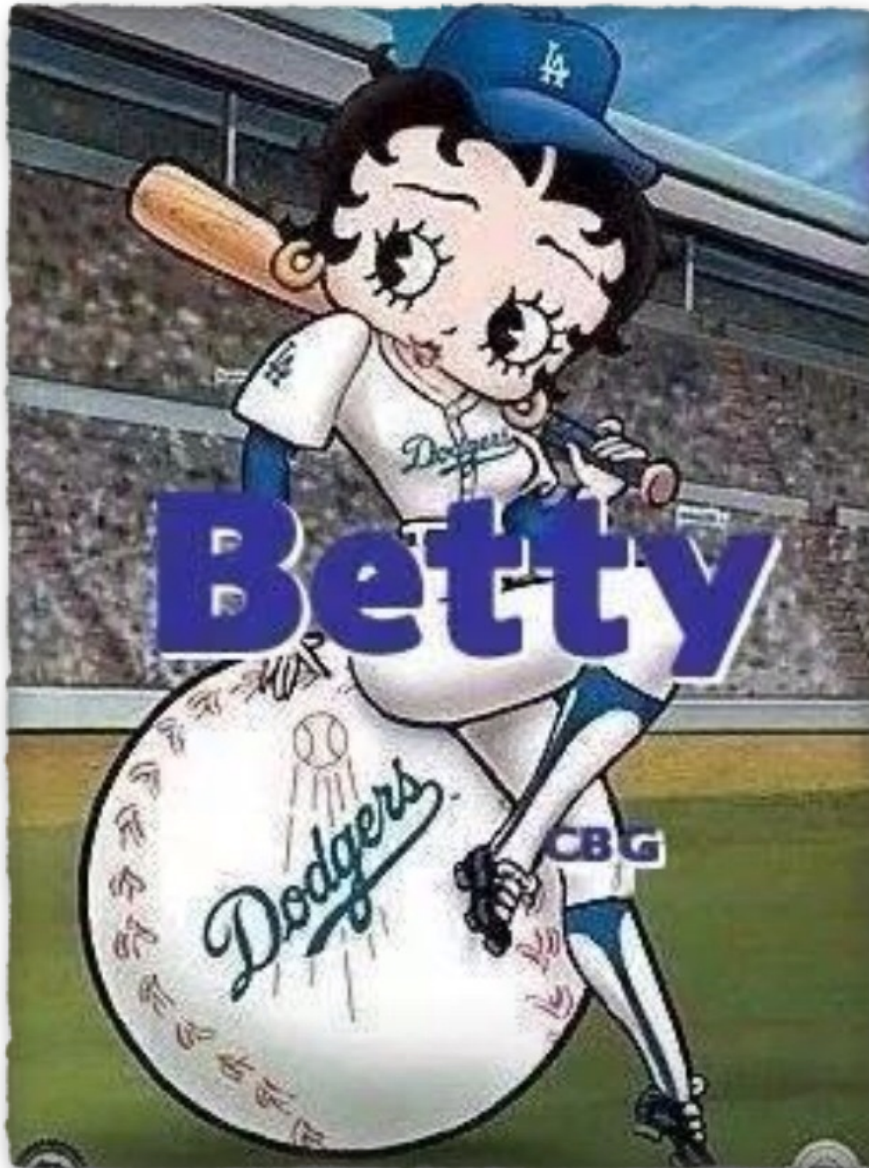
The Antelope Valley Corvette Club is a non-profit organization formed by those who are proud of America's greatest and longest

MISCELLANEOUS:

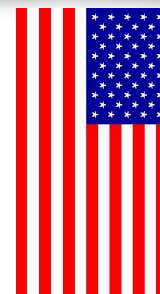
- Pamela won the 50/50 raffle for \$34.50
