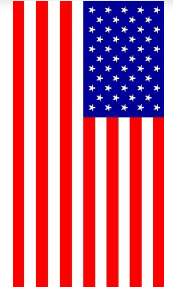

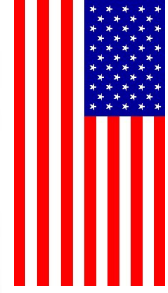

The 80 Corvettes were divided into four groups led by a police car with lights on all the way to Memphis.
