MISCELLANEOUS:

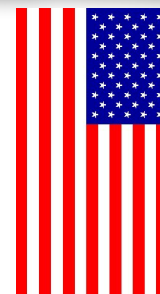
- Gordon and Pam won the 50/50 raffle , \$26
